Overview

VFS has established a Visiting Scholars program, the goal of which is to facilitate the residency of a limited number of distinguished scholars from other academic institutions or accomplished professionals whose expertise coincides and is relevant to the program they wish to visit. Visiting Scholar positions are non-compensated appointments established to accommodate the Scholar's goals as well as enrich the VFS teaching and learning community. Length of the appointment will be determined by VFS.

Criteria

Work Permits

VFS does not provide work permit or immigration support for these appointments; this is the responsibility of the Visiting Scholar.

English Language Proficiency

In addition, all Visiting Scholars must demonstrate ELP based on VFS language standards:

- IELTS Band 6.5 Academic level
- TOEFL score of 80 internet-based (iBT), or 550 paper-based (PBT)
- PTE score of 58 64
- TOEIC score of 785
- Cambridge CAE or FCE completion of any level with Grade A or B
- LPI Level 5
- Duolingo score of 61 or higher

How to Apply as a Visiting Scholar

The Process

- 1. Complete the Application Form below.
- 2. Include a current resume and copies of educational credentials
- 3. Include a copy of English Language Test certificate (see above)
- 4. Submit an employment verification letter from your current employer, including details on sabbatical (if applicable).
- 5. Three letters of recommendation
